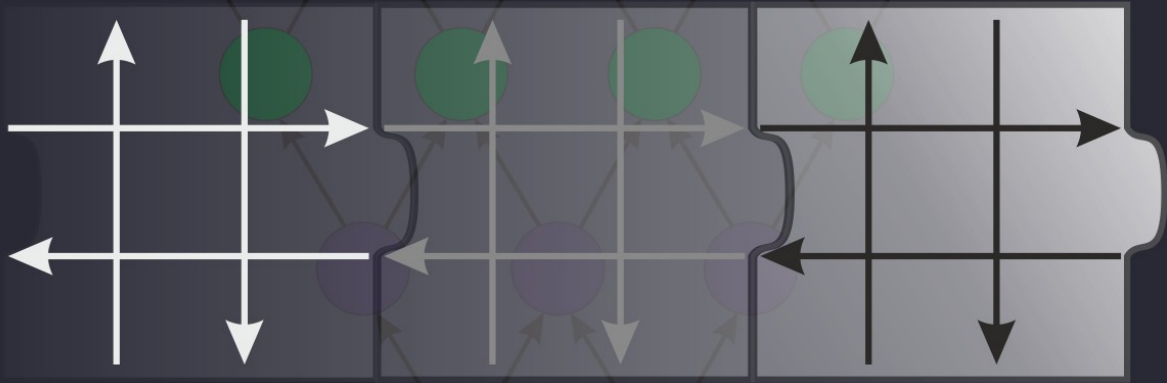

Acta logistica

Dear authors, readers, editors, reviewers and supporters of the journal Acta logistica (AL). For the journal Acta logistica was year 2019 ground-breaking and significant. The journal Acta logistica was abstracted and indexed in the next databases as Publication Forum (Finland) and Scopus (Elsevier).

What are the statistics about the journal for the year 2019?

- The journal Acta logistica published 25 reviewed articles.
- The review process did not accept 12 (32%) contributions for publishing.
- The journal AL increased the number of printed publications by 25% in 2019.
- The journal AL increased the number of printed articles' pages by 45% (58 pages more) to a total 186 pages in 2019.
- The number of contributions received in 2019 increased by 36%.
- The number of authors and co-authors in published articles is 59 from 9 countries (Czech Republic, Finland, Hungary, Israel, Malaysia, Mexico, Poland, Russia, Slovak Republic), and with many received citations. 63% are foreign authors and co-authors, 37% are authors and co-authors from the Slovak Republic.
- The number of reviewers for all contributions (published or rejected) is 33 from 6 countries (Czech Republic, Hungary, Indonesia, Mexico, Poland, Slovak Republic).

In the year 2020 the Editorial board is planning to publish 20% more articles than in the year 2019. 92% of all publications were published free of charge in 2019. The Editorial board of the journal AL will accept of the fee waiver policy in 2020 too.

In 2019, the journal Acta logistica recorded significant web visits and tracking not only within Europe but around the world. Based on an annual analysis in 2019, the journal has been watched in more than 40 countries around the world (Argentina, Australia, Austria, Brazil, Canada, Czech Republic, Finland, France, Germany, Hungary, Chile, China, India, Indonesia, Italy, Kazakhstan, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Mexico, Morocco, Namibia, Netherlands, New Zealand, Nigeria, Norway, Pakistan, Panama, Poland, Portugal, Russian Federation, Singapore, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Taiwan, Thailand, Ukraine, United Kingdom, United States, Vietnam). Average monthly page views of the journal AL www.actalogistica.eu site was 773; average monthly visitors were 177 and average monthly new visitors were 154.
