Acta logistica

Dear authors, readers, editors, reviewers and supporters of the journal Acta logistica (AL). The year 2020 will forever be associated mainly with the COVID-19 pandemic, which also influenced the focus of some scientific articles in the journal. The authors of some articles have tried to capture the impact of a pandemic on society, as well as logistics and transport. Despite the difficult situation associated with the pandemic, the journal managed to meet and exceed the established plans, for which many thanks to all who were very willing to help.

What are the statistics about the journal for the year 2020?

- The journal Acta logistica published 34 reviewed articles.
- The review process did not accept 13 contributions.
- The journal AL increased the number of printed articles by 36% in 2020.
- The journal AL increased the number of printed articles' pages by 65% (121 pages more) to a total 307 pages in 2020.
- The number of contributions received in 2020 for review process was 63 and increased by 66%.
- The number of authors and co-authors in published articles is 121 from 18 countries (Croatia, Czech Republic, Finland, Germany, India, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Latvia, Mexico, Morocco, Peru, Poland, Russian Federation, Slovak Republic, Thailand, Ukraine, Vietnam) and with many received citations. 69.4% are foreign authors and co-authors, 30.6% are authors and co-authors from the Slovak Republic.
- The number of reviewers for all contributions (published or rejected) is 45 from 10 countries (Czech Republic, Germany, Hungary, Malaysia, Mexico, Poland, Russian Federation, Slovak Republic, Thailand, Ukraine).

In 2021, the Editorial board of the journal plans to publish 20% more articles than in 2020. In 2020, the journal Acta logistica recorded significant web visits and tracking not only within Europe but around the world.
