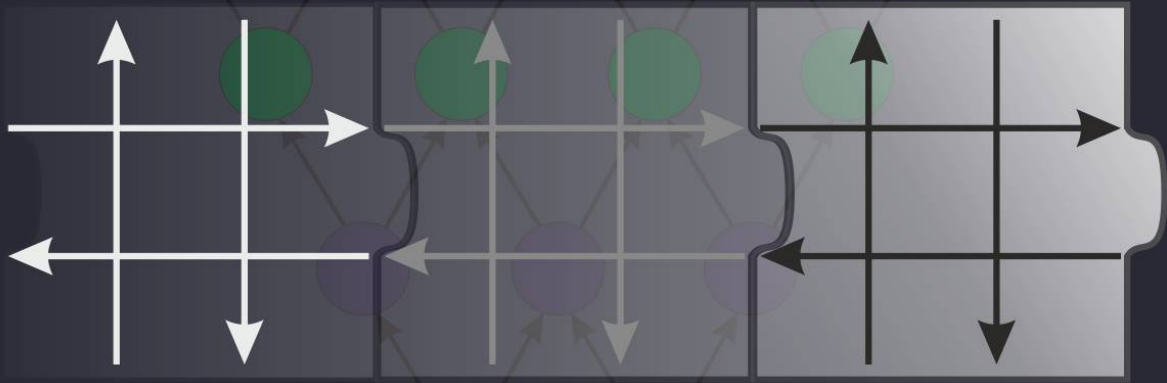

## ANNUAL REPORT 2021

### Acta logistica

Dear authors, readers, editors, reviewers and supporters of the journal Acta logistica (AL). For the journal, Acta logistica was the year 2021 significant and very successful. The journal Acta logistica was abstracted and indexed in the Norwegian Register for Scientific Journals, Series and Publishers database. Despite the difficult situation associated with the pandemic, the journal managed to meet and exceed the established plans, for which many thanks to all who were very willing to help.

What are the statistics about the journal for the year 2021?

- The journal Acta logistica published 44 reviewed articles.
- The review process did not accept 26 contributions.
- The journal AL increased the number of printed articles by 29% in 2021.
- The journal AL increased the number of printed articles' pages by 55% (170 pages more) to 477 pages in 2021.
- The number of contributions received in 2021 for review process was 73 and increased by 16%.
- The number of authors and co-authors in published articles is 136 from 19 countries (Australia, Bangladesh, Colombia, Czech Republic, Hungary, India, Indonesia, Italy, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Marocco, Mexico, Peru, Poland, Slovak Republic, South Africa, Thailand, Ukraine) and with many received citations. 73.5% are foreign authors and co-authors, 26.5% are authors and co-authors from the Slovak Republic.
- The number of reviewers for all contributions (published or rejected) is 47 from 15 countries ([Argentina](#), [Colombia](#), [Czech Republic](#), [Hungary](#), [India](#), [Indonesia](#), [Jordan](#), [Mexico](#), [Poland](#), [Russian Federation](#), [Slovak Republic](#), [Taiwan](#), [Thailand](#), [Ukraine](#), [USA](#)).

In 2022, the journal's Editorial Board plans to publish 10% more articles than in 2021. In 2021, the journal Acta logistica recorded significant web visits and tracking within Europe and around the world. Based on an annual analysis in 2021, the journal has been watched in more than 97 countries worldwide. Average monthly page views of the journal AL [www.actalogistica.eu](http://www.actalogistica.eu) site was 1 200; average monthly visitors were 273, and average monthly new visitors were 226.
